May Open Meeting	Attend the May open meeting to provide and receive feedback for the SCJLS.	15
Marketing Workshop	Attend the fall marketing workshop.	15
Junior Board	Become an active member of the Junior Board. The coordinator has the right to determine who is and is not an active member.	15
Validation	Actively participate in Smith County validations, including but not limited to paperwork, holding animals, and assisting with set up and cleanup.	5 points each
SCJLS Sanctioned Events	Actively participate in Smith County Junior Livestock Show sanctioned events. <i>*These are determined by the Board*</i>	10
Sponsorships	Gain "Friend of the Show" sponsors. The sponsor must tell us your name and points will be awarded upon payment. <i>*Sponsor must not be related to the participant*</i>	20
Raffle Tickets	Raffle ticket totals sold before March 30, 2023.	1 point per 2 tickets sold
